DBP Practitioner Audits

- Audit a registered or former registered practitioner
- Audit the preparation of regulated designs
- Audit the preparation of compliance declarations and other required documents
- Audit the carrying out of building work




Data & Analytics

- Practitioners who have previously been the subject of enforcement or disciplinary action
- Practitioners who have been the subject of a complaint
- Practitioners undertaking the design of buildings of high technical complexity
- Practitioners who have worked on projects which have the potential to affect a large number of people.
- Practitioners who have worked on projects which involve high risk materials (e.g. non-compliant cladding).
- Serious defects in building elements or building projects observed from building audits under other Fair Trading legislation, such


as those conducted under the Residential Apartment Buildings (Compliance and Enforcement Powers) Act 2020.

6. What we are looking for in a regulated design

Construction Issued Regulated Design (CIRD)

DBP Regulation 3A : Meaning of construction issued regulated design

- Contains the necessary detail to produce building work that would achieve compliance with the BCA
- Can be used by the building practitioner to carry out the work in accordance with the regulated design and the BCA

Integration with other regulated designs and building work

- Designs are project specific
- Designs are coordinated



Roof drainage design is not coordinated


Architect indicates three (3) rainwater outlets




Lift pit drainage with reverse slope



Building Commission NSW

Fire services designs are being declared too early

- Sprinklers are not dimensioned from walls or grid lines.
- Booster assemblies and pumps are schematic without providing a scaled or dimensioned detail with the necessary access space.
- Calculations, designs and compliance with the BCA are delegated to the contractor.
- Designs refer to performance solutions that have not been prepared yet.
- Lack of standard details to assist other design practitioners to integrate with e.g. details with required clearances around hydrant valves, clearances around pumps etc






